Young workers aren't just leaders for tomorrow, they can lead today!

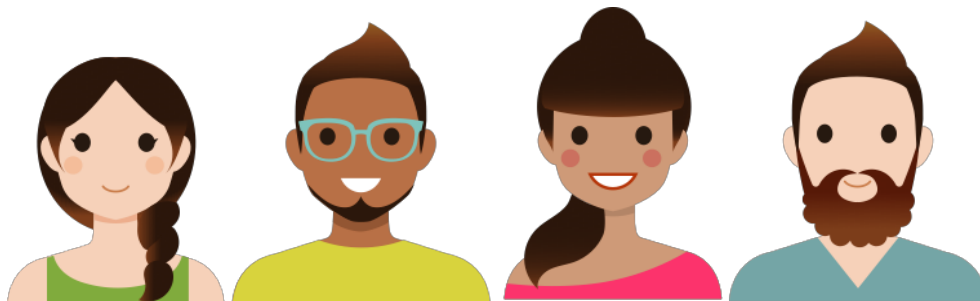
The MFL celebrates the important role that young workers play in our labour movement with the Young Member Achievement Award. This award is given to an outstanding young member who demonstrates exceptional leadership skills and a deep commitment to the labour movement. The award is issued every three years at the MFL convention (May 24-27, 2018, RBC Convention Centre, Winnipeg).

Nominees will be 35 years of age or under and be a member of an MFL affiliated union or labour body. Nominees will have:

- Been active and showed leadership in their union and/or the MFL;
- Made a significant contribution to the labour movement in furthering the work of reaching out to young workers – organized and unorganized; and
- Furthered the objectives of the MFL in increasing the participation of young workers in their unions, their workplaces, the MFL and the wider community.
